ΟΝΕS

The Rational, Idealistic Type:

Principled, Purposeful, Self-Controlled, and Perfectionistic

- Ones look for: shared purpose and values, equality, fairness, integrity
- A common trend that gets in Ones' way is:
 insisting on being right at the own

insisting on being right at the expense of connection with others

• Ones can become manipulative by: correcting others and playing on their sense of guilt and inadequacy

Twos

The Caring, Interpersonal Type: Demonstrative, Generous, People-Pleasing, and Possessive

- Twos look for: emotional connection, intimacy, warmth, affection
- A common trend that gets in Twos' way is: insisting on exclusivity and ever more closeness with others
- Twos can become manipulative by: finding out others' needs and desires, and creating dependencies

THREES

The Success-Oriented, Efficient Type: Adaptive, Excelling, Driven, and Image-Conscious

- Threes look for: recognition and are attracted to success and prestige
- A common trend that gets in Threes' way is: being excessively driven, competitive, and political
- Threes can become manipulative by: charming others and by adopting whatever image will "work"

FOURS

The Sensitive, Introspective Type: Expressive, Dramatic, Self-Absorbed, and Temperamental

- Fours look for: communication, listening, acceptance, and emotional honesty
- A common trend that gets in Fours' way is:

insisting on having all their emotional needs met immediately

 Fours can become manipulative by: being temperamental and making others walk on eggshells



FIVES

The Intense, Cerebral Type: Perceptive, Innovative, Secretive, and Isolated

- *Fives look for:* curiosity, intensity, involvement, non-intrusiveness
- A common trend that gets in Fives' way is: insisting on personal space and non-interference
- Fives can become manipulative by: staying preoccupied with ideas and projects, and detaching emotionally

SIXES

The Committed, Security-Oriented Type: Engaging, Responsible, Anxious, and Suspicious

- *Sixes look for:* commitment, dependability, shared values, solidarity
- A common trend that gets in Sixes' way is: self-doubt and reactivity, and alternating between needing closeness and needing distance
- Sixes can become manipulative by: complaining and testing others' commitment to them

SEVENS

The Busy, Variety-Seeking Type:

Spontaneous, Versatile, Distractible, and Scattered

- *Sevens look for:* stimulation, adventure, excitement, variety
- A common trend that gets in Sevens' way is: insisting on postponing making commitments
- Sevens can become manipulative by: staying upbeat and hyperactive, and insisting others meet their need for gratification

EIGHTS

The Powerful, Dominating Type:

Self-Confident, Decisive, Willful, and Confrontational

- *Eights look for*: dependability, honesty, strength, energetic compatibility
- A common trend that gets in Eights' way is: insisting on maintaining control of others
- Eights can become manipulative by: dominating others and demanding that others do as they say

NINES

The Easygoing, Self-Effacing Type: Receptive, Reassuring, Agreeable, and Complacent

- *Nines look for*: comfort, peace, harmony, stability
- A common trend that gets in Nines' way is: insisting on not acknowledging problems and remaining neutral
- Nines can become manipulative by: checking out and passive-aggressively resisting others
